### Sclero-what?!?

Scleroderma is a **rare**, **chronic**, **multisymptom autoimmune disease** that affects the body's connective tissue.

In scleroderma, a person's immune system works against itself resulting in excess tissue collagen throughout the body. This overproduction of collagen can prevent the body's organs from functioning properly. In some forms of scleroderma, patches of hard, tight skin are the extent of this irregular collagen over-production process.

In the systemic forms, the problem goes much deeper, and can severely affect blood vessels and internal organs such as the heart, lungs, kidneys, and digestive tract.


